Franck Durif is Professor of Neurology (since 2001), specialized in Movement Disorders and head of the Neurology department at Clermont-Ferrand University hospital. He is running the Clermont-Auvergne University research unit working on the neuro-psycho-pharmacology of sub-cortical dopaminergic systems (EA 7280 / UCA). Franck Durif is co-chairing the NS-Park/F-CRIN Neurosciences Network on clinical research in PD. He also chaired the French network on Deep Brain Stimulation in PD before it merged with NS-PARK. Franck Durif is an active member of the “Club des mouvements anormaux” (past-treasurer), and of associations such as France Parkinson (French patients association for PD), or PSP France (French patient association for progressive supranuclear palsy). He created and chairs the “Société Francophone des Mouvements Anormaux” since 2017. Franck Durif’s main fields of interest are the exploration of non-motor symptoms of PD such as neuropsychological and psychiatric dimensions, DBS, neuroimaging and other movement disorders such as the essential tremor. He is a member of the editorial board of the journals *Neurologies* and *Mouvement* and is reviewer for several journals in the movement disorders field (*Brain*, *Neurology*, *Movement Disorders*, *Journal of Neurology*, *Neurosurgery* and *Psychiatry*, *European Journal of Neurology*....). Franck Durif has published 208 original articles in peer review journals (H index=34).
